Project: New Zealand House

Location: Haymarket, London, UK

Project Description:

New Zealand House is an iconic, listed building and has had a long association with Verosol. In 1973 Verosol sheer curtains were installed to the building and 35 years later as part of a major refurbishment Verosol were invited to replace the curtains with roller blinds.

Roller blinds with 816 (semi-transparent fabric) are left permanently lowered to help control heat and light gain but still allow an excellent view out of the building.

Rollers with 878 dim-out fabric were installed in areas where staff needed additional light exclusion or where heat gain posed a particular problem.

Requirements:

- Control of thermal gain
- Control of glare

Solution:

1,500 roller blinds with Trevira CS fabric, manually operated:

816
Light transmission 27%
Solar transmission 29%

Light transmission 3%
Solar transmission 4%
